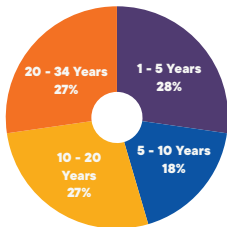

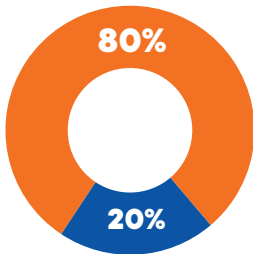
- Treatment for alcoholism, drug addiction, and co-occurring disorders

Robust Sobriety Post-Treatment

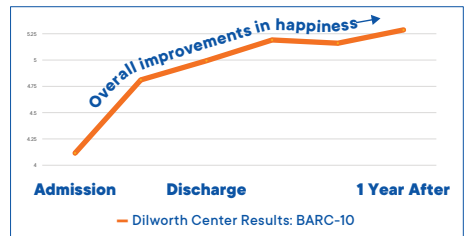


Proven Sustained Recovery

As part of our national partnership with the Foundation for Recovery Science & Education and based on hundreds of respondents, **80% of Dilworth Center patients report sobriety one year after treatment**, and 79% at two years, demonstrating Dilworth Center's lasting impact.

In general I am happy with my life is part of the survey which measures recovery resources. Our results show overall improvements during and after treatment.

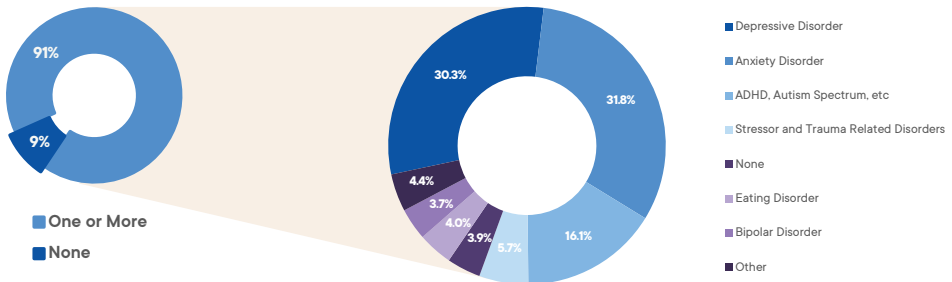


Dual Solutions

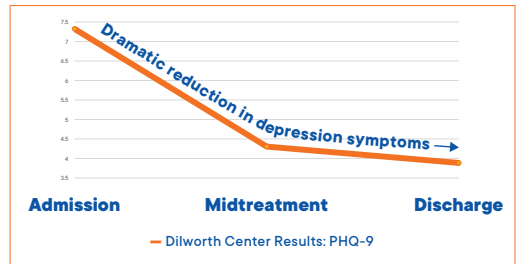

Mental Health Matters



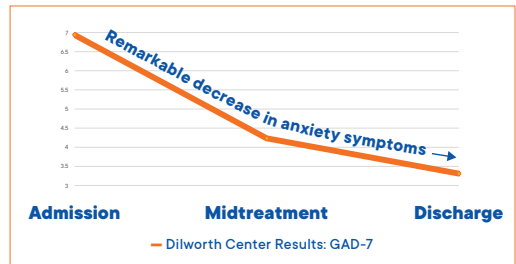
Depression Scale (PHQ-9)

The PHQ-9, assessing the criteria for depression, shows notable improvement in depressive symptoms during treatment at Dilworth Center.



Anxiety Scale (GAD-7)

The GAD-7 assesses anxiety and its severity. Similar to depression, our patients show remarkable improvements in anxiety.
